01 Luke 10:29-37 But he, desiring to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" 30 Jesus replied, "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and he fell among robbers . . . 36 Which of these three, do you think, proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell among the robbers?" 37 He said, "The one who showed him mercy." And Jesus said to him, "You go, and do likewise."

LOVE ONE ANOTHER

02 John 13:34-35 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

03 Galatians 5:14 For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

04 1 John 3:11, 23 For this is the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. . . 23 And this is his commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love one another, just as he has commanded us.

05 1 John 4:7, 11-12 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. . . 11 Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 12 No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.

06 1 John 4:21 And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother.

07 2 John 5 And now I ask you, dear lady— not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning— that we love one another.

08 Romans 13:8, 10 Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. . . 10 any other commandment, are summed up in this word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

09 James 2:8 If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well.

10 Matthew 5:43-44 "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,

11 Matthew 19:19 Honor your father and mother, and, You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

12 Mark 12:31 The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

13 1 Peter 1:22 Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart,

BUILD UP (ENCOURAGE) ONE ANOTHER

14 Romans 14:19 So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding.

15 1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.

16 Hebrews 10:24-25 And let us . . . encourage one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

17 Romans 15:2 Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up.

EXHORT ONE ANOTHER

18 Hebrews 3:13-14 But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.

STIR UP ONE ANOTHER TO LOVE AND GOOD DEEDS

19 Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works,

BE KIND (DO GOOD) TO ONE ANOTHER

20 1 Thess 5:15 See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.

21 Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

LIVE IN HARMONY WITH ONE ANOTHER

22 Rom 12:16 Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be conceited.

23 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you, have unity of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind.

ACCEPT ONE ANOTHER

24 Rom 15:7 Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

SERVE ONE ANOTHER

25 Galatians 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

HAVE CONCERN FOR ONE ANOTHER

26 1 Cor 12:25 that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.

CARRY (BEAR) EACH OTHERS BURDENS

27 Gal 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

28 Eph 4:2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love,

29 Col 3:13 bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

TEACH AND ADMONISH ONE ANOTHER

30 Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

PRAY FOR ONE ANOTHER

31 James 5:16 Therefore, . . . pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

CONFESS SINS TO ONE ANOTHER

32 James 5:16a Therefore, confess your sins to one another . . .

DON'T JUDGE ONE ANOTHER

33 Rom 14:13a Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, . . .

34 James 4:11-12 . . . The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge. 12 There is only one lawgiver and judge, he who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor?

DON'T SLANDER ONE ANOTHER

35 Lev 19:16 You shall not go around as a slanderer among your people, and you shall not stand up against the life of your neighbor: I am the Lord.

36 James 4:11a Do not speak evil against one another, brothers.

37 Prov 11:12-13 Whoever belittles his neighbor lacks sense, but a man of understanding remains silent. 13 Whoever goes about slandering reveals secrets, but he who is trustworthy in spirit keeps a thing covered.

DON'T PROVOKE ONE ANOTHER

38 Gal 5:26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, . . .

DON'T ENVY ONE ANOTHER

39 Gal 5:26 Let us not . . . envy one another.

BE DEVOTED TO ONE ANOTHER

40 Rom 12:10 Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

HONOR (GIVE PREFERENCE) TO ONE ANOTHER

41 Rom 12:10b . . . Outdo one another in showing honor.

42 1 Cor 10:24 Let no one seek his own good, but the good of his neighbor.

PLEASE YOUR NEIGHBOR

43 Ro 15:2 Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up.

SPEAK TRUTH TO ONE ANOTHER

44 Eph 4:25 Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.

DO NOT COVET ANOTHER'S THINGS

45 Ex 20:17 "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor's."

DO NOT BE A STUMBLING BLOCK FOR ANOTHER

46 Rom 14:13 Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

47 1 Cor 8:11-13 And so by your knowledge this weak person is destroyed, the brother for whom Christ died. 12 Thus, sinning against your brothers and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ. 13 Therefore, if food makes my brother stumble, I will never eat meat, lest I make my brother stumble.

BE TRUSTWORTHY - DO NOT GOSSIP ABOUT ANOTHER

48 Prov 25:9-10 Argue your case with your neighbor himself, and do not reveal another's secret, 10 lest he who hears you bring shame upon you, and your ill repute have no end.

WASH ONE ANOTHER'S FEET

49 John 13:14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. 15 For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you.

LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE FOR OTHERS

50 Matt 5:16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

FORGIVE ONE ANOTHER

51 Matt 6:14-15 For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, 15 but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

52 Col 3:13b . . . forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

53 Eph 4:32b . . . forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

54 Matt 18:21-22, 35 Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times?" 22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you seven times, but seventy times seven. . . 35 So also my heavenly Father will do to every one of you, if you do not forgive your brother from your heart.

55 Luke 17:3-4 "Pay attention to yourselves! If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him, 4 and if he sins against you seven times in the day, and turns to you seven times, saying, 'I repent,' you must forgive him."

DO NOT JUDGE ONE ANOTHER

56 Luke 6:37a "Judge not, and you will not be judged . . .

57 Rom 2:1-3 Therefore you have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges. For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things. 2 We know that the judgment of God rightly falls on those who do such things. 3 Do you suppose, O man—you who judge those who do such things and yet do them yourself—that you will escape the judgment of God?

58 Rom 14:13 Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother.

59 James 4:11-12 Do not speak evil against one another, brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. SUBMIT TO ONE ANOTHER

60 Eph 5:21 Submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.

PERSUADE ONE ANOTHER ABOUT CHRIST

61 2 Cor 5:11 Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we persuade others. But what we are is known to God, and I hope it is known also to your conscience.

DO NOT BOAST ABOUT SELF WITH ONE ANOTHER

62 2 Cor 10:15-18 We do not boast beyond limit in the labors of others. But our hope is that as your faith increases, our area of influence among you may be greatly enlarged, 16 so that we may preach the gospel in lands beyond you, without boasting of work already done in another's area of influence. 17 "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord." 18 For it is not the one who commends himself who is approved, but the one whom the Lord commends.

COUNT OTHERS MORE SIGNIFICANT (HUMILITY)

63 Phil 2:3 Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.

LOOK AFTER THE INTERESTS OF OTHERS

64 Phil 2:4 Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

DO NOT JOIN OTHERS IN SINNING

65 1 Tim 5:22a, 24 Do not be hasty in . . . taking part in the sins of others; keep yourself pure.

TEACH ONE ANOTHER

66 2 Tim 2:2 What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

67 Rom 15:14 I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to instruct one another.

68 Col 3:16a Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, . . .

SAVE ONE ANOTHER

69 Jude 22-23 And have mercy on those who doubt; 23 save others by snatching them out of the fire; to others show mercy with fear, hating even the garment stained by the flesh.

70 Matt 18:15 "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother.

BE HUMBLE WITH ONE ANOTHER

71 Prov 27:2 Let another praise you, and not your own mouth; a stranger, and not your own lips.

72 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you, have . . . a humble mind.

73 1 Peter 5:5 Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

BE HOSPITABLE WITH ONE ANOTHER

74 1 Peter 4:9 Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.

75 Rom 16:16a Greet one another with a holy kiss. . . .

LIVE IN UNITY WITH ONE ANOTHER

76 1 Cor 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment.

77 Eph 4:2-3 . . . bearing with one another in love, 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

78 1 Cor 12:25 That there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.

BE COMPASSIONATE WITH ONE ANOTHER

79 Zech 7:9 Thus says the Lord of hosts, . . . show kindness and mercy to one another,

80 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you, have . . . sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind.

BE KIND TO ONE ANOTHER

81 Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

SING/SPEAK TO ONE ANOTHER IN PSALMS

82 Eph 5:19 Addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with all your heart,

DO NOT HATE ONE ANOTHER

83 Titus 3:3 For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, slaves to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating one another.

HAVE FELLOWSHIP WITH ONE ANOTHER

84 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

BE CIVIL TO ONE ANOTHER

85 Matt 5:22 But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, 'You fool!' will be liable to the hell of fire.

BE RECONCILED TO ONE ANOTHER

86 Matt 5:24 Leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

DO NOT TRANSGRESS ONE ANOTHER THROUGH SEXUAL IMMORALITY

87 1 Thess 4:3-6 For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; 4 that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, 5 not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God; 6 that no one transgress and wrong his brother in this matter,

DO NOT ENCOURAGE IDLENESS IN ONE ANOTHER

88 2 Thess 3:6 Now we command you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from any brother who is walking in idleness and not in accord with the tradition that you received from us.

CARE FOR ONE ANOTHER

89 James 2:15-16 If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that?

90 1 John 3:17-18 But if anyone has the world's goods and sees his brother in need, yet closes his heart against him, how does God's love abide in him? 18 Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.

91 Prov 3:29-30 Do not plan evil against your neighbor, who dwells trustingly beside you. 30 Do not contend with a man for no reason, when he has done you no harm.

92 Prov 14:21 Whoever despises his neighbor is a sinner, but blessed is he who is generous to the poor.

DO NOT HATE ONE ANOTHER

93 1 John 2:9-11 Whoever says he is in the light and hates his brother is still in darkness. 10 Whoever loves his brother abides in the light, and in him there is no cause for stumbling. 11 But whoever hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

94 1 John 4:20 If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.

DO NOT LEND TO ONE ANOTHER (Become dependent)

95 Proverbs 6:1-3 My son, if you have put up security for your neighbor, have given your pledge for a stranger, 2 if you are snared in the words of your mouth, caught in the words of your mouth, 3 then do this, my son, and save yourself, for you have come into the hand of your neighbor: go, hasten, and plead urgently with your neighbor.

DO NOT TAKE REVENGE ON ONE ANOTHER

96 Proverbs 24:28-29 Be not a witness against your neighbor without cause, and do not deceive with your lips. 29 Do not say, "I will do to him as he has done to me; I will pay the man back for what he has done."

GOLDEN RULE: Do unto others as you would have them do unto you. [53RD Category]

97 Matt 7:12 "So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets."

98 Luke 6:31 And as you wish that others would do to you, do so to them.
